Girls Summer Development Program – Summer 2026

New for Summer 2026, Team Addy is proud to launch our **Girls Summer Development Program**, designed to support skill development and provide a high-quality basketball environment for girls throughout the **Guelph–Wellington** area all summer long.

This program is focused on **player development, competition, and opportunity**—giving girls a place to train, compete, and grow during the offseason.

Program Overview

We plan to field **four summer teams**, all led by **OBA-certified coaches** and supported by an outstanding group of guest coaches, including:

- Current varsity university players
- University and college coaches
- The area's top shooting coach, **James Scott**

Teams will train **2–3 times per week** and compete in the **Summer Coalition League** in Toronto. Select teams will also attend **one of Canada's premier girls tournaments in Montreal (June 26–27)**.

Teams

Understanding that summer schedules can be busy, Team Addy summer teams will feature **extended rosters**. Each team will carry up to **20 athletes**, with **10–12 players selected per game**, allowing flexibility while maintaining competitive standards.

- **U12** – Girls entering **Grade 7** in September 2026
- **U13** – Girls entering **Grade 8** in September 2026
- **U14** – Girls entering **Grade 9** in September 2026

Open Gym Scrimmages (U15–U17)

Team Addy is also hosting **FREE Open Scrimmage Nights** for all **high-level girls** in the Guelph area.

- **Who:** U15–U17 girls (rep & top high school level)
- **When:** Tuesdays & Thursdays, **7:00–9:00 PM**

These sessions are designed to give players a chance to **play, compete, and be seen**. We want to see girls hoop.

Like all Team Addy programming, this program is offered as **NON-PROFIT**. **NONE** of the coaches, administration, management are paid. This is **100% volunteer!**

Fees for this program will be shared with the players and will only include, gym rental, tournament fees, etc.
